

P. pseudoecheneis seems to inhabit part of niche of Kali Gandaki's Euchiloglanis hogarti.

N. beavani instead of N. rupecola but showed (?) into a sand and sand/gravel habitat (by P. pseudoecheneis?). Few beavani in rocky r. flats. Most found in sand and sand/gravel.

Locals say Kabre can be caught here also. KGR locals say the same for some upstream areas in that river. (Pseudoecheneis sulcatus).

Locals had dynamited stream a few days ago. A large (ca 400 g) kettle decomposing on bottom of pool.
